HOW WE STARTED

In the aftermath of the Military Coup in February 2021, the majority of students, teachers and professors left the military controlled educational institutions as part of the Civil Disobedience Movement.

As of 2023, around

350,000 Students

10,000 Professors and Lecturers

remain out of Higher Education Institutions

Beyond university students, millions of children and young people across Myanmar, especially those in conflict zones or living as internally displaced, need safe, inclusive, quality education.

Spring University Myanmar was founded in May 2021 to support the interim education while fundraising for scholars at risk.

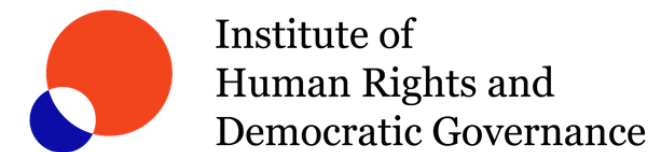

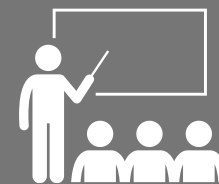
EDULAMP / SUM BOX

A device developed by SUM that enables digital learning without the internet

SCHOLARSHIPS AND PRIVATE CLASSES

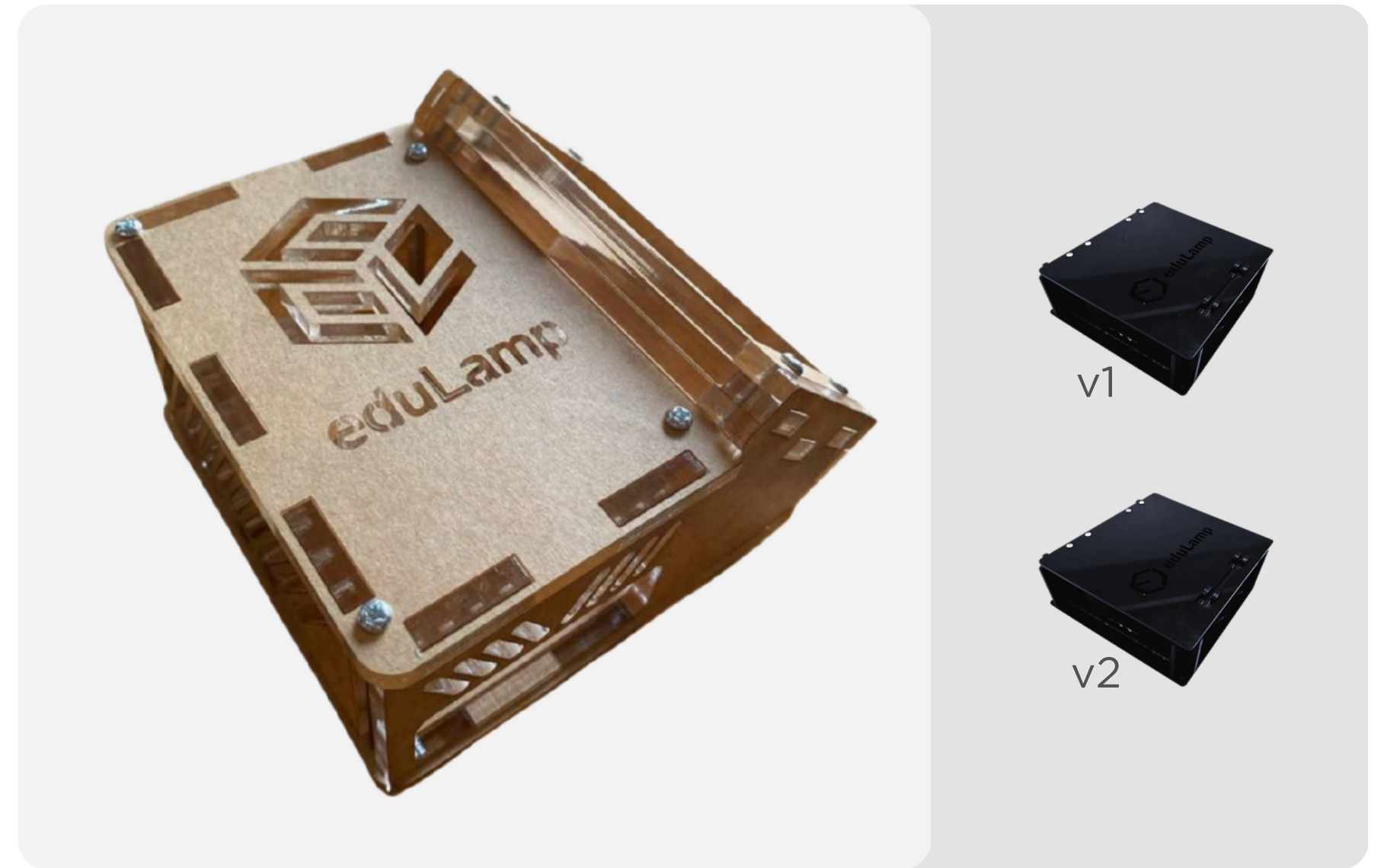
Scholarships are provided to students in need with the majority being recruited through local partners. Private classes with full scholarships are also available for partners

eduLamp SUM BOX

What is it?

The eduLamp Box is simple and user-friendly. Once the box is powered up, learners within a 30-50 feet radius can connect to the local Wi-Fi hotspot that eduLamp distributes. After connecting, learners can access the eduLamp learning management portal through any mobile device browser, which contains all the courses, materials, and assessments. Each eduLamp Box can support up to 30 simultaneous users, allowing learners to study at their own pace together.

For those who do not have access to mobile devices, community-based learning with a projector is an alternative solution. eduLamp understands the importance of providing equal opportunities to all students and the approach is designed to be as inclusive as possible.



eduLamp Features

- Automatic cloud-synchronization with low bandwidth
- Touch-screen configuration for local admin
- Storage capacity at 64 gb (expandable)
- Multiple educational platforms and games

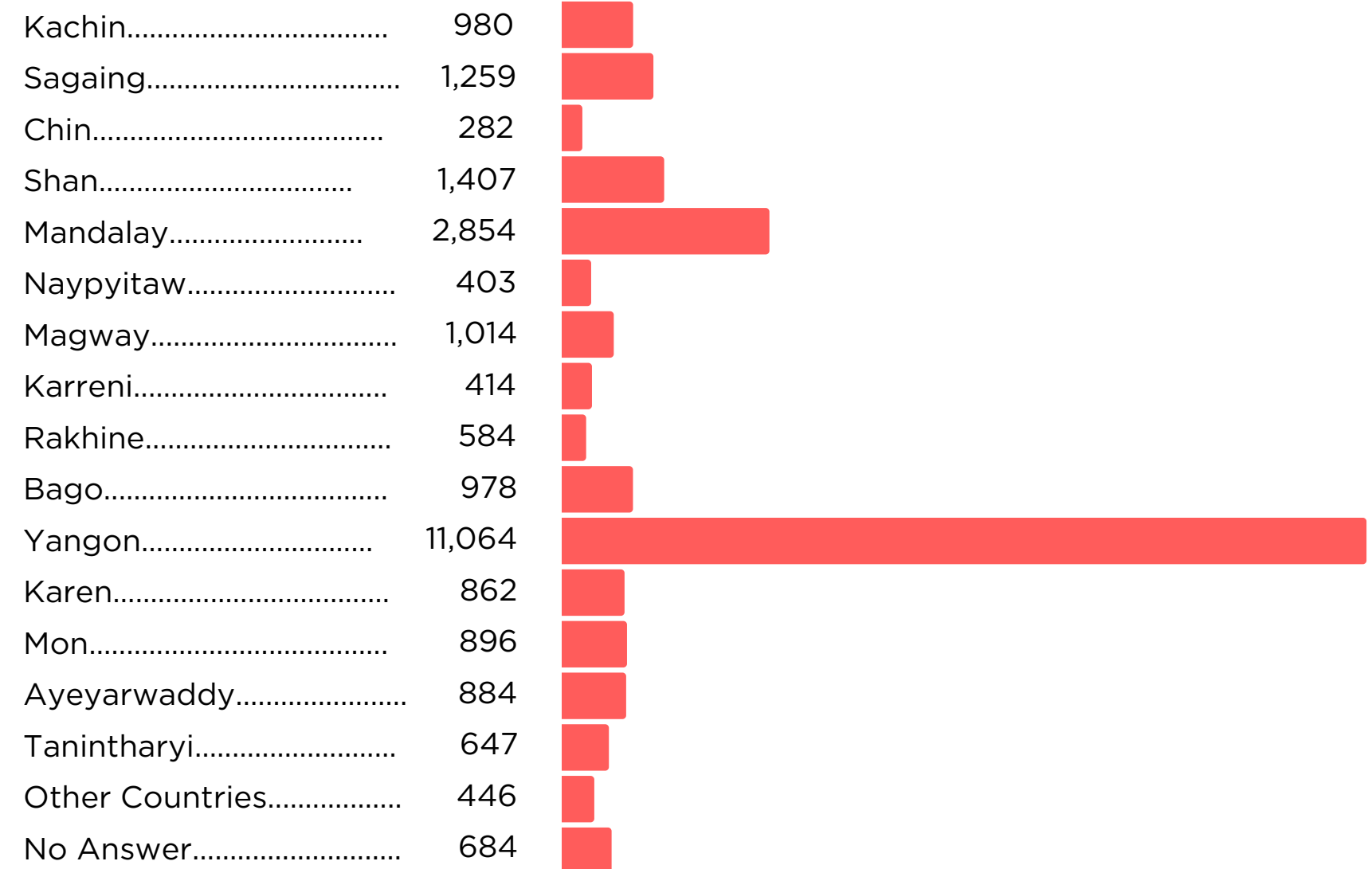

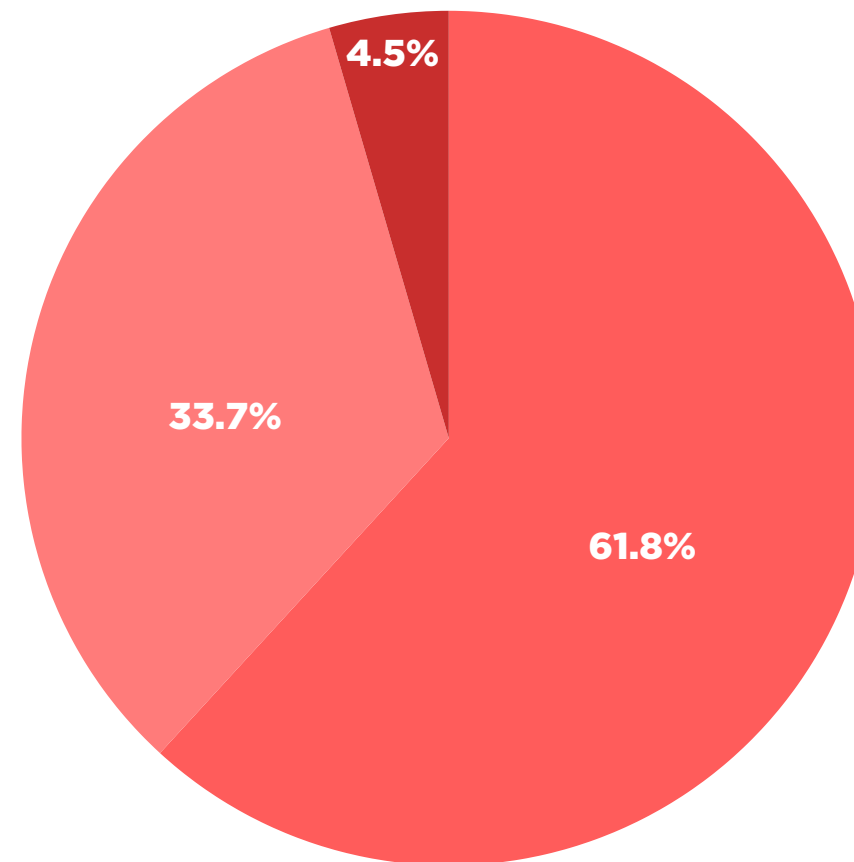

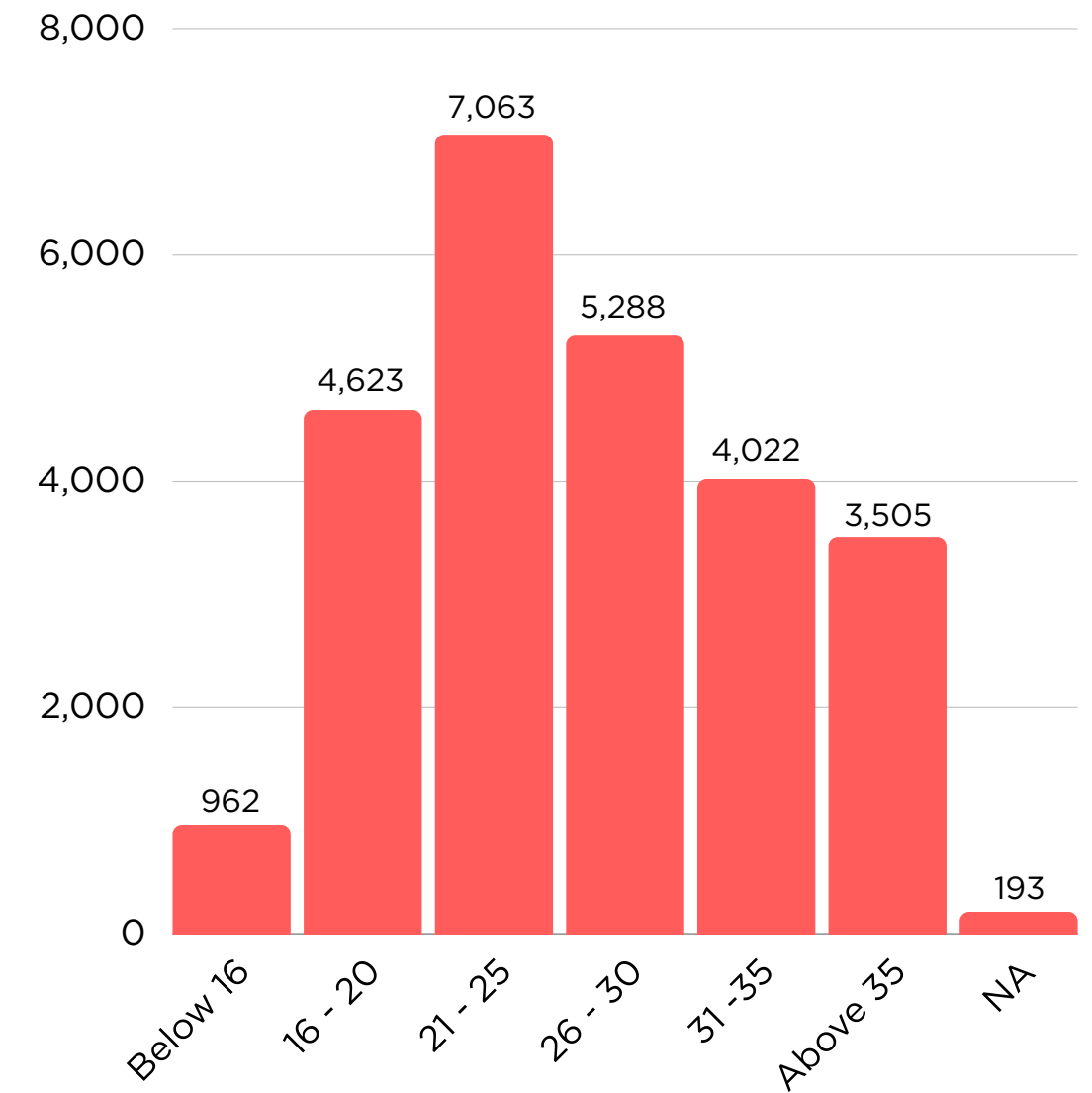

POSSIBLE AREAS FOR COLLABORATION

SYSTEM STRENGTHENING:

In coordination with ethnic education departments, community initiatives in liberated areas, local online learning platforms, migrant education programs, admissions to universities in Southeast Asia.

ACCESS TO ONLINE COURSES FROM UK UNIVERSITIES:

SUM providing shadow education support for Myanmar students, localisation of online courses from UK universities, integrating UK online courses into eduLamp for regions with no internet connectivity, jointly developing and delivering new programs.

SUM ORGANISATIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Re-strategising and diversifying SUM's partnerships outside the US, re-aligning with the development sector landscape and private sector/ vocational training, scaling up asynchronous and hybrid learning resources.
